1. Testing & Education Reference Center.の構成

Testing & Education Reference Center(以下、TERC)の構成は以下の5つに分かれています。

Career Tools:	各職業における試験対策教材 Virtual Career Library 等
Graduate School Tools:	大学院入学基礎学力認定試験 GMAT, GRE 等
International Tools:	英語コミュニケーション能力を測る試験 TOEFL, TOEIC 等

それぞれは、Test Prep(テスト・試験準備)と Other Tools(関連する様々な情報)に分かれています。



2. テスト利用方法

Test Prep は、①ebook を閲覧するもの、と②オンライン・テストに分かれます。

①ebookのものはRead Bookとありますのでそのまま PDF で電子ブックを閲覧します。



②オンライン・テストをする場合は簡易な Register (ユーザー登録) とログインが必要となり ます。これはテスト結果をセーブしたり残しておくためのものです。テスト結果はユーザー登録 単位で記録されるため、同一テストを再度行う場合は新たにユーザー登録をします (ユーザー登 録数に制限はありません)。
